General Plan Update

The current Carnegie State Vehicular Recreation Area (SVRA) General Plan was adopted in 1981. Much has changed at Carnegie SVRA since 1981, including the acquisition of new SVRA properties. Preparation of a new Carnegie SVRA General Plan began in 2012, since then data has been collected, the existing conditions have been documented, and extensive public outreach has been conducted.

In November and December 2013, the Carnegie General Plan team hosted two public workshops and an online activity to receive input on the preferred concept. Over 400 people attended these workshops and approximately 1,210 comments were received through the online activity.

This feedback is being used to further refine the preferred concept for inclusion in the General Plan.

Since the online exercise finished last December, the Carnegie General Plan team has been developing the administrative draft of the General Plan and Environmental Impact Report. That process is making good progress and is nearing completion.

Next Steps

Once completed, the preliminary Draft General Plan and associated Draft Environmental Impact Report will be made available for public review. This is anticipated to occur in Fall 2014.
